

THE FINE CUT

We welcome new Member Frank Drob to the Club – it is hoped your stay with us will be enjoyable and rewarding. Frank has donated two cutting boards and a set of woodworking books to the Club, and we offer our thanks to him for that.

Member Steve Brown has advised he has a drum of “AVS Hybond GP (Bostick)” PVA glue/concrete sealer – this is similar to Aquadhere white glue - he wants to sell, and he will bring it to the August Saturday Worksop.

It is about 5-6 years old but still sticks well even on end grain.

Cost is \$2.00 per litre or part thereof, however you must bring your own containers.

I actually used this some years ago and it was a good product back then.

Our next BBQ is at Bunnings (North Penrith) on Saturday 15 September 2012, and we are again asking for volunteers to help out during the day.

As usual there will be two shifts – 7.30am to NOON and NOON to 4.30pm.

This is our last BBQ for the year, so please see me at one of our Meetings to book in.

We also want four volunteers who are willing to each slice and bag 4kg of onions for the BBQ – you will be fully reimbursed for the onions, so get a receipt please – again see me about this.

At this time each year, we are required to get the Club’s electrical tools tested and tagged (T & T) by a licensed Electrician, and in line with previous years you are invited to bring **ONE** of your personal tools from home to be T & T.

This should be a tool you would bring to a Meeting to use yourself or by/with another Member/s at the Hall.

You should be aware that Government Regulations do not allow a non T & T tool to be used at our Meetings under any circumstances.

As only extremely small quantities of what is a rather costly product are required to be used in mixing paint or stain (eg the mix Max Sinclair gave us as a finisher at a previous Meeting – and it works well too), the Club has purchased a product named Terebine (a paint hardener), and will provide it to Members free of cost.

So if you need/want some, bring along a small bottle.

Our last Bus trip for the year is on Wednesday 31 October 2012.

This time we are going to a cabinet making/Joinery works at Milperra – I am told this is a factory that uses computers to design kitchens, etc and to cut all the components.

Whether it also fabricates is not known at this stage – sort of makes one feel obsolete or passed by really.
